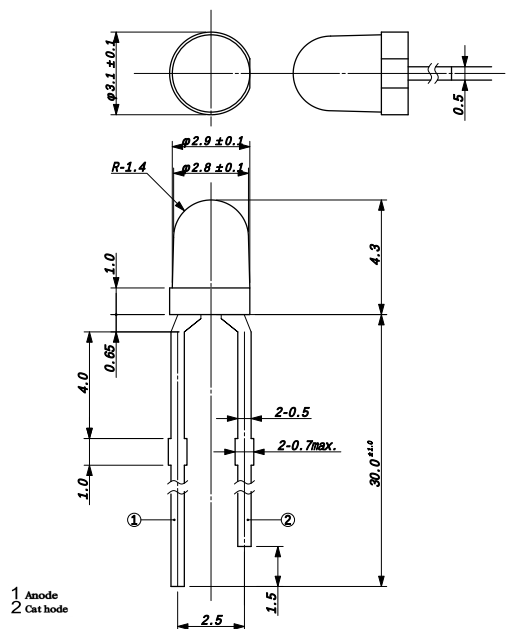

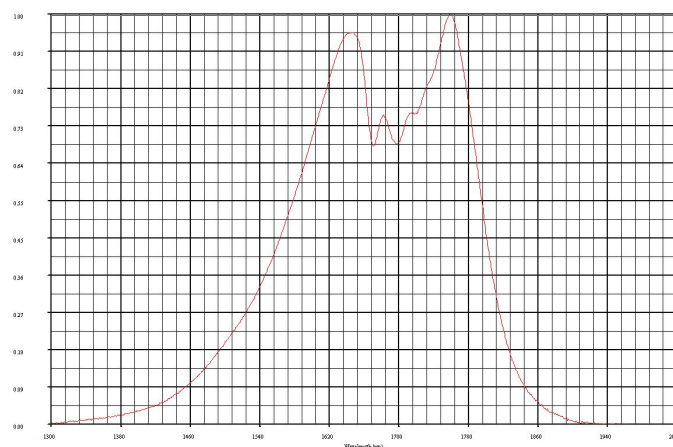

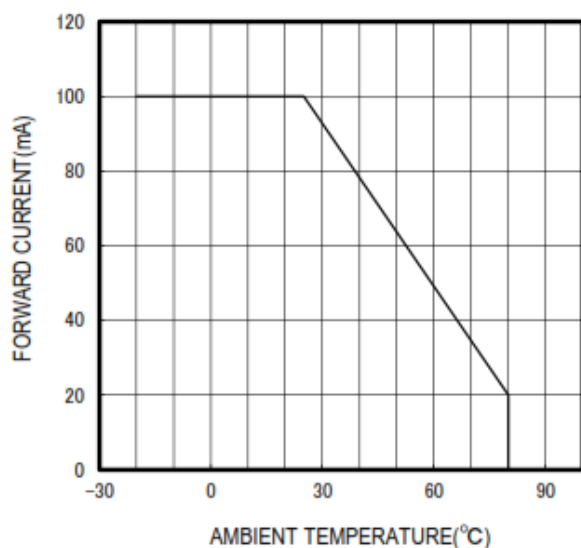

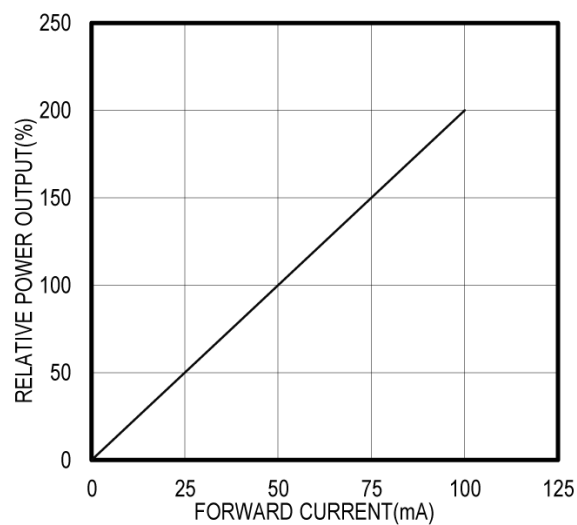
SPECTRAL RESPONSE



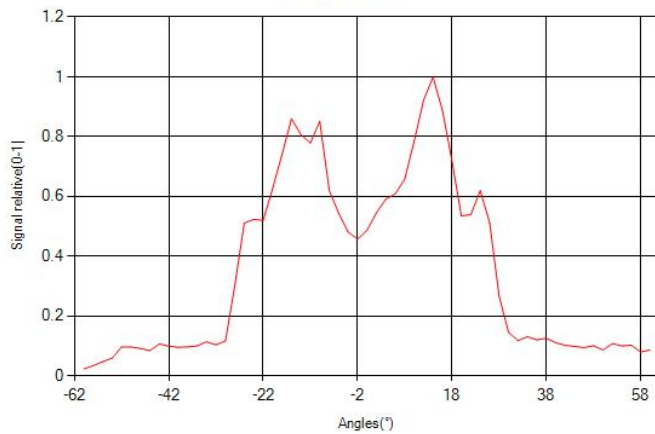
THERMAL DERATING CURVE



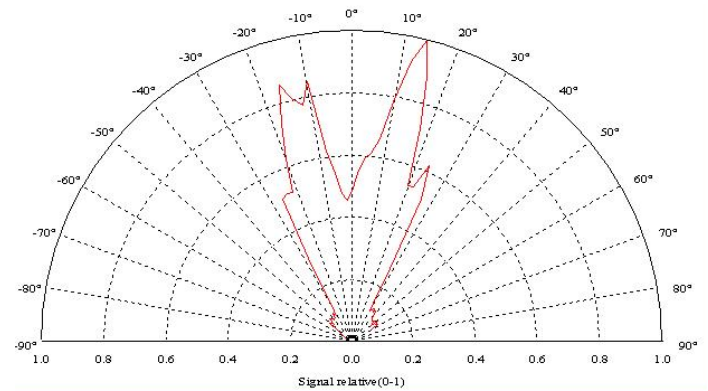
RELATIVE POWER vs FORWARD CURRENT
