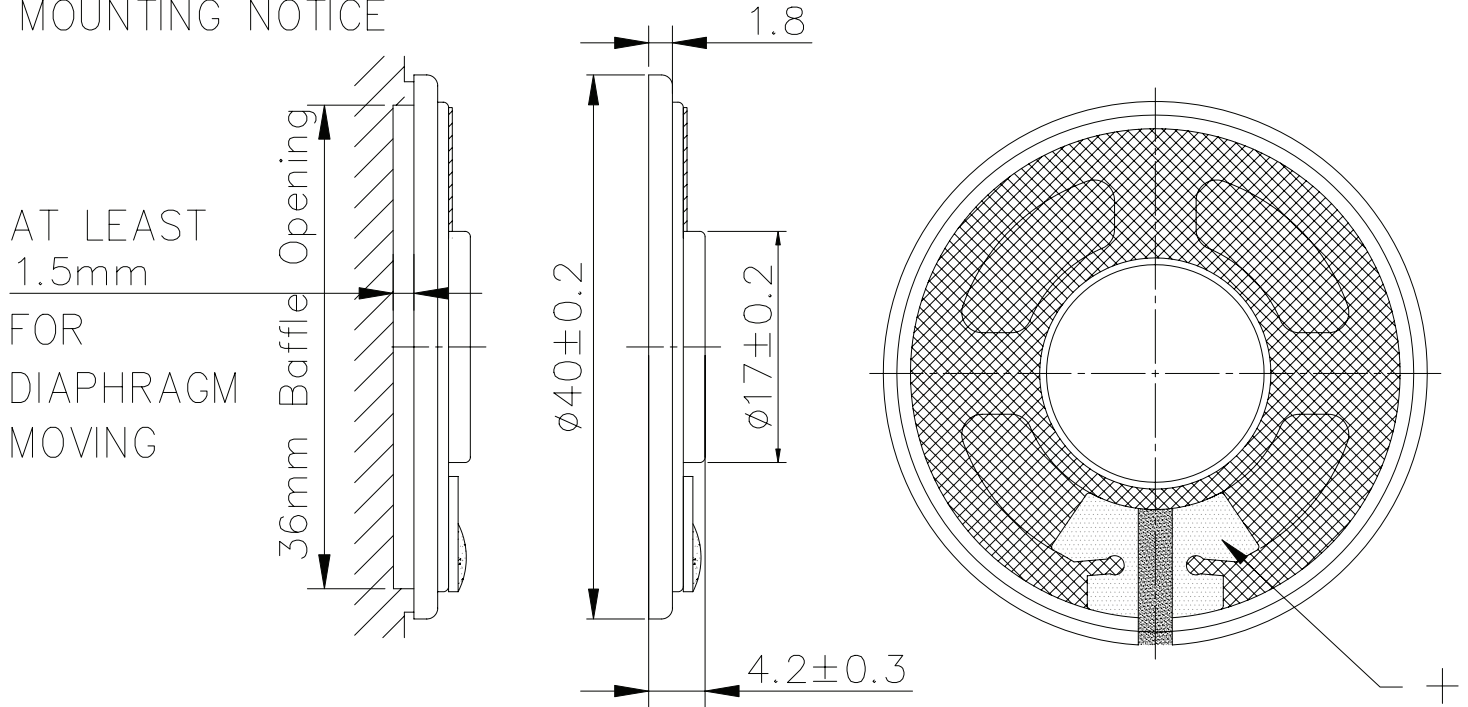

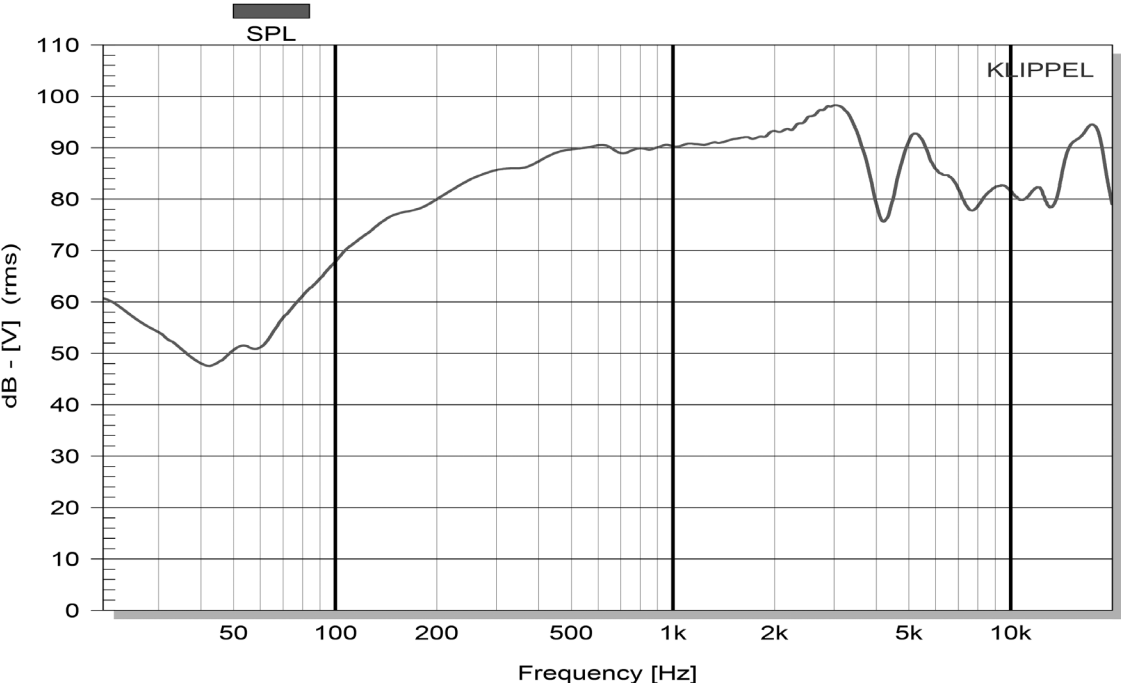

RESPONSE CURVES

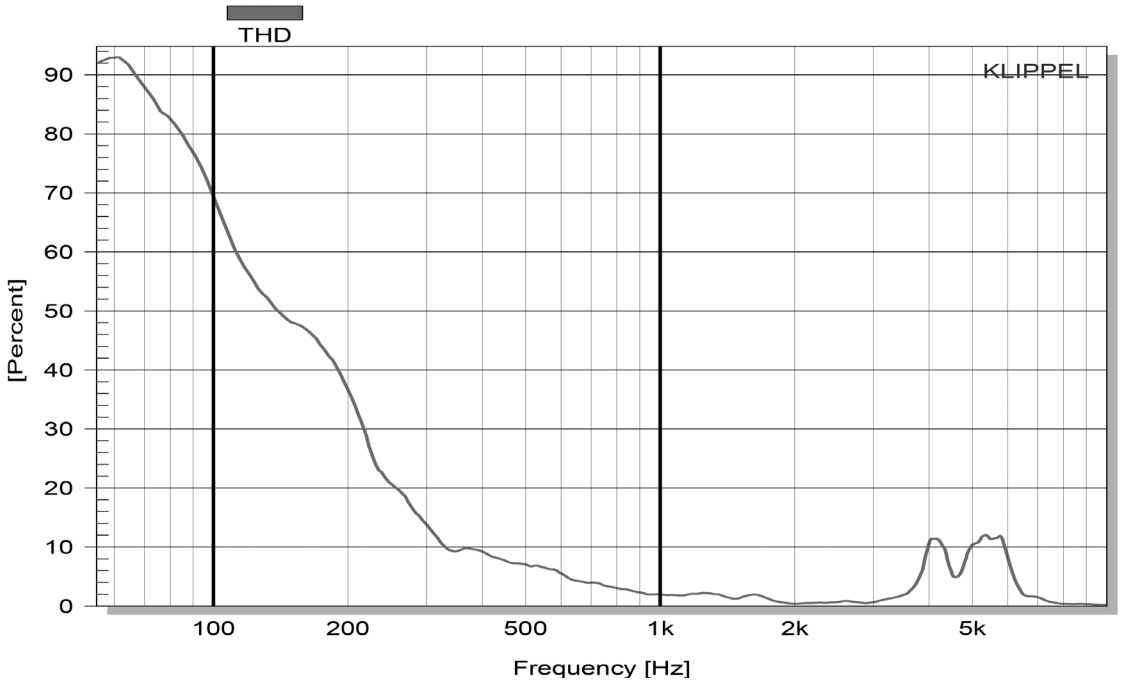
Frequency Response Curve
