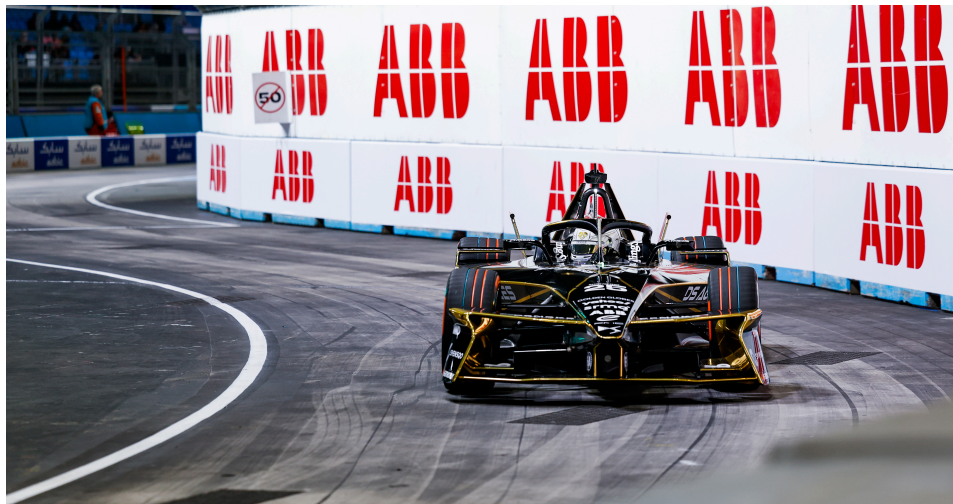


SEASON FINALE  
DS PENSKE CLOSED OUT SEASON 11  
FINISHING 5<sup>th</sup> IN TEAMS' CHAMPIONSHIP



- DS PENSKE cumulated 184 points in Season 11 to finish fifth in the Teams' classification
- Unforgettable pole-to-victory races for Maximilian Günther in both Jeddah and Shanghai
- Jean-Éric Vergne finished 6th in the Driver's Standing
- Standout performances – Multiple double-points finishes and both drivers inside the Top 10 in drivers' standing

**London, July 27, 2025** – DS PENSKE brought Season 11 to a close this weekend at the action-packed Marvel Fantastic Four London E-Prix, securing **fifth place** in the FIA Formula E Teams' Championship after a year defined by intensity, determination, and world-class teamwork.

From São Paulo to Shanghai, via rain-soaked streets in Tokyo and the sun-drenched corners of Monaco, the Franco-American outfit completed a demanding 16-race calendar with **184 points on the board** and both drivers finishing inside the **Top 10** in the Drivers' Standings — **Jean-Éric Vergne (6th)** and **Maximilian Günther (10th)**.

The season delivered moments of brilliance and grit in equal measure:

- **Double-points finishes** in **Mexico City, Jeddah, Monaco, and Shanghai**
- A **sensational pole-to-victory drive** for Max in both **Jeddah and Shanghai**, underlining the performance edge of the DS E-TENSE FE25
- A **season-defining performance** in Shanghai, with **Pole, P1, P2, and Fastest Lap** — a near-flawless weekend that captured the team’s spirit and potential
- Consistently strong qualifying runs, with both drivers advancing to the Duels from the very first round in São Paulo

Despite fierce competition, DS PENSKE proved its resilience, consistently battling at the sharp end of the grid. Every race brought new challenges, but the team met them with unshakable resolve — learning, adapting, and evolving.

While the championship results may not reflect every ambition, the progress made, the lessons learned, and the unity forged will serve as a powerful springboard for what’s to come.

As the checkered flag fell on Season 11, the team now shifts its focus to the future. The off-season will be dedicated to regrouping, recharging, and returning stronger — ready to chase new milestones in Season 12.
